The Eastern Interconnection Planning Collaborative (EIPC) has completed development of two power flow models representing the planned transmission systems for 2018 and 2023 and will shortly post a draft report that describes the models, input assumptions, and results of reliability and transfer testing. The report will be posted on the EIPC web site [here](#). A webinar will be held on December 13, 2012 at 9:30am Eastern time to present the report and answer questions about the models and the process used to create them.

In addition, the webinar will discuss how these two models will be used in scenario analyses planned for 2014. Two sample scenarios will be discussed as well as the process to collect stakeholder input on scenarios. To assist stakeholders in the process of developing potential scenarios of their own for consideration by EIPC, the "Principles and Guidelines for EIPC Stakeholder Scenario Development Associated with the Creation and Analysis of Roll-up Models" was posted earlier.
