### Recent SSC Events and Activities

- The Stakeholder Steering Committee (SSC) last met February 7-8, 2011, in Arlington, VA. During that meeting, and a follow-up virtual meeting held February 11, the SSC approved the 8 Futures and 72 sensitivities to be modeled in Phase 1 of this study. The SSC also approved all of the modeling inputs for Future 1, Business As Usual (BAU) and the first 8 Sensitivities. - The Modeling Work Group (MWG) has been working to specify the modeling inputs for the remaining Futures and sensitivities. They met in person immediately following the SSC meeting on February 9<sup>th</sup> and data subteams have been meeting weekly by phone. At the SSC Webinar held March 15<sup>th</sup> the MWG gave an overview of key decision items they will present to the SSC at its upcoming meeting. The March 15<sup>th</sup> webinar recording and summary will be posted to the website shortly.
- Also at the March 15<sup>th</sup> SSC Webinar, the SSC approved changes to its Charter as proposed by the Governance Task Force. The changes were related to the deadlines for distributing meeting materials to stakeholders. A redline version of the charter which shows these changes may be viewed [here](#).
- The EIPC released the Roll-up Report on March 7<sup>th</sup> and the Roll-up Work Group has been compiling a list of lessons learned to share with the SSC at its next meeting.
